Einstein grew up in Germany in a middle-class Jewish family. He criticized Germany's education system because it was too strict. When he was just 10 years old a Polish medical student started **tutoring** Einstein in higher mathematics and philosophy. Einstein gave up his German **citizenship** so he could avoid joining the army. He entered a university in Switzerland. Even in university, Einstein remained an independent thinker who often skipped classes. He preferred to study on his own. He had many great scientific ideas while working a boring job as a clerk in a patent office. Einstein is famous for his **theories** about light, **gravity**, space, and time. His most famous idea is $E = mc^2$. It means that energy (E) and **mass** (m) are different forms of the same thing. He also developed the general theory of relativity, a foundation of physics. In 1916 he suggested there's a force on gravity that balances the universe. Although he later called it the biggest mistake of his life, scientists now feel he might have been correct after all.
