## 13 Health

Health education provides learners with an introduction to the human body and ways to prevent illness and promote health. Three goals of health education are to increase a child's health knowledge, to create positive **attitudes**, and to promote healthy behavior. Students learn various health themes: **nutrition**, disease prevention, **reproduction**, drug and alcohol abuse prevention, and safety (crossing streets, riding bikes, and first aid). In Japan, the number of overweight and **diabetic** youth has been increasing. Awareness of the causes of these conditions can help people avoid being affected by them. To reduce **fatal** diseases such as heart disease, the Japanese government made a policy of health examinations in 2008. People at risk are given information or medicine.


